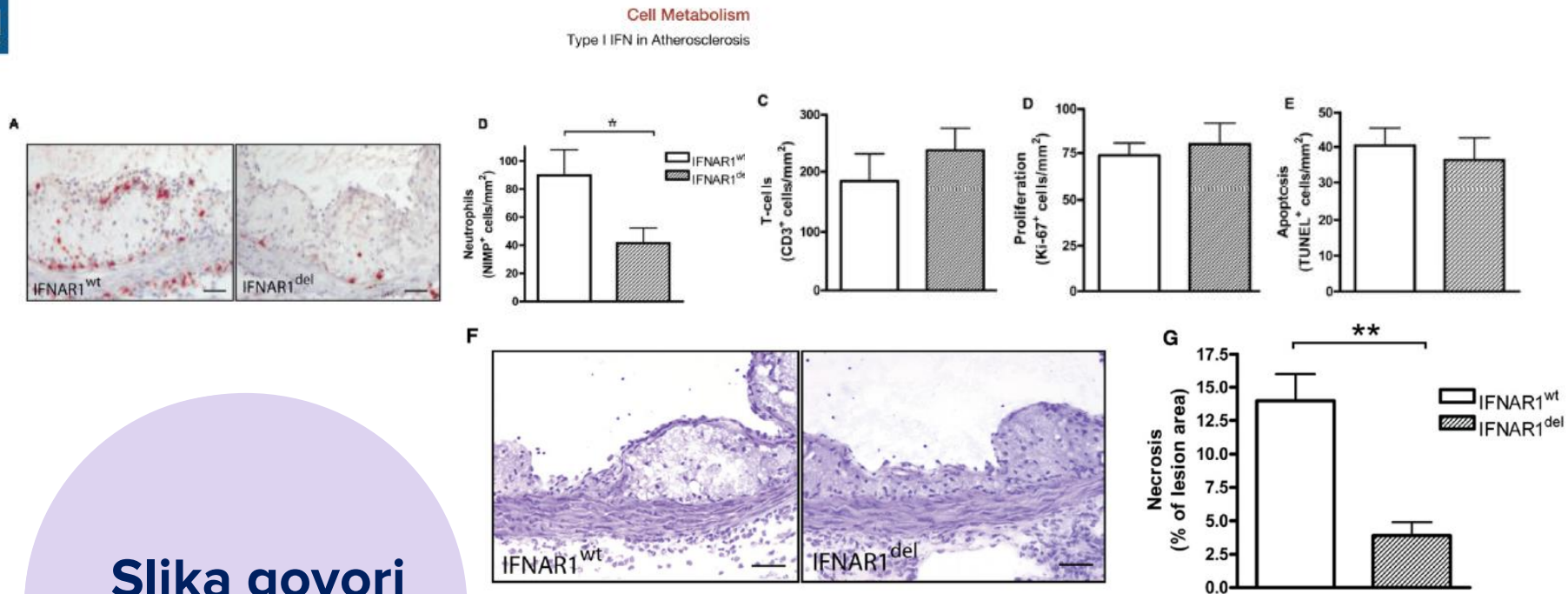

Ranije su naučni radovi pisani za manju akademsku zajednicu i komplikovane rečenice su bile uobičajene.

William James alluded to the development which he gave to Peirce's expression of the principle. In one sense one can say that he enlarged the bearing of the principle by the substitution of particular consequences for the general rule or method applicable to future experience. But in another sense this substitution limited the application of the principle since it destroyed the importance attached by Peirce to the greatest possible application of the rule, or the habit of conduct—its extension to universality. That is to say, William James was much more of a nominalist than Peirce.

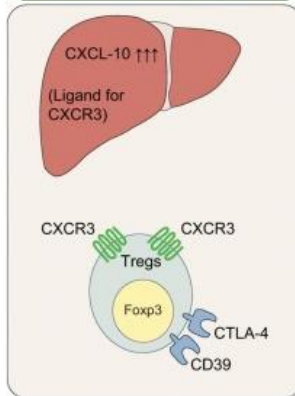
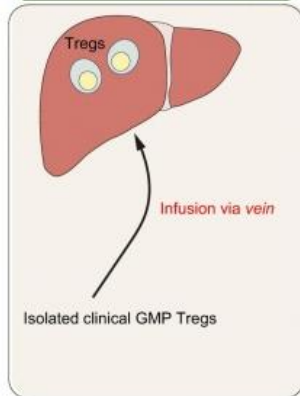
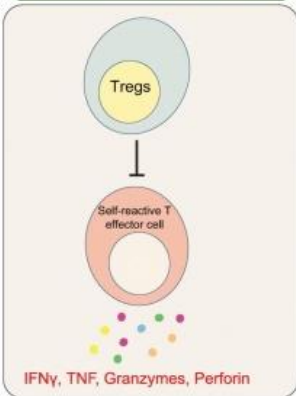

## Abstract

### Objective

The purpose of this study was to explore the subjective accounts of weight-recovered female patients, who met DSMIV criteria for anorexia nervosa (AN), regarding their views of their illness following weight restoration.

### Method

Qualitative semi-structured interviews were administered to 15 participants to ascertain their perspective of the factors that either contributed to their maintaining a healthy weight, or the factors involved in their having relapsed over the follow-up period.

### Results

Qualitative analyses revealed six core categories: internal motivation to change, recovery as a work in progress, the perceived value of the treatment experience, developing supportive relationships, awareness and tolerance of negative emotion and self-validation.

### Discussion

This study provides valuable information about the way in which AN patients experience their illness and highlight the factors that help or hinder recovery. These findings may help enhance relapse prevention programs and potentially enhance our ability to identify and target those individuals at the greatest risk of relapsing. 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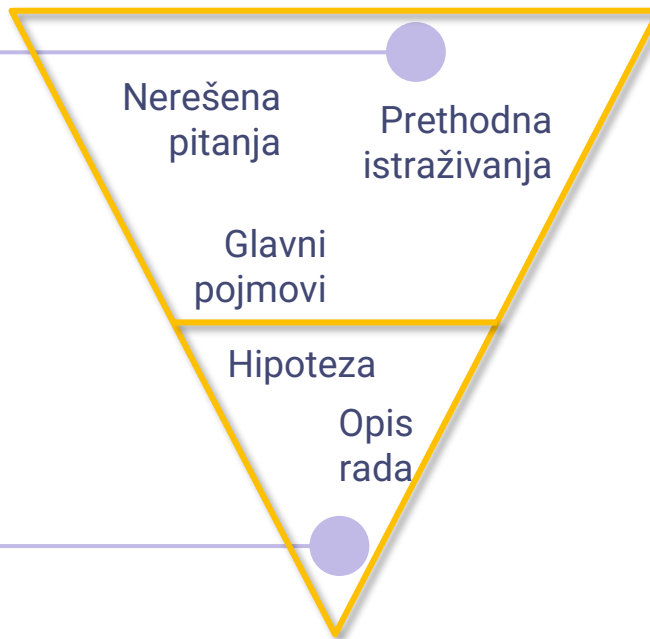

### *Introduction*

1 Polylactide (PLA) has received much attention in recent years due to its biodegradable properties, which offer important economic benefits. 2 PLA is a polymer obtained from corn and is produced by the polymerisation of lactide. 3 It has many possible uses in the biomedical field<sup>1</sup> and has also been investigated as a potential engineering material.<sup>2,3</sup> 4 However, it has been found to be too weak under impact to be used commercially.<sup>4</sup>

5 One way to toughen polymers is to incorporate a layer of rubber particles<sup>5</sup> and there has been extensive research regarding the rubber modification of PLA. 6 For example, Penney *et al.* showed that PLA composites could be prepared using blending techniques<sup>6</sup> and more recently, Hillier established the toughness of such composites.<sup>7</sup> 7 However, although the effect of the rubber particles on the mechanical properties of copolymer systems was demonstrated over two years ago,<sup>8</sup> little attention has been paid to the selection of an appropriate rubber component.

**1** This paper investigates the history of miracles in Catholicism and the historical context of the Third French Republic. **2** The analysis found that the secularisation of miracles was an attempt by the Catholic Church to alleviate uncertainty and ensure legitimacy in the eyes of believers in the era of the rise of secularism in France. **3** In this paper, first, the change in conceptualization of miracles is examined. Emphasis is put on the mobilizing power of miracles which was recognized by the Catholic Church. **4** Second, the secularisation of miracles in 19th century France is compared to the rationalisation of miracles in the 16th century. **5** The comparison shows that by allowing a space where medical sciences would determine what does not qualify as a miracle, the Church ultimately left the possibility for a miracle open and ensured its position as the ‘guardian of the supernatural’.



There are at least two reasons to be optimistic that we are witnessing a move towards a greater degree of realism in economic science (TS). (EL) Firstly, economics has become increasingly suspicious of econometric results (McCloseky, 2000). (IL) Statistical significance and large cross-sectional studies have lost some of their significance, as economists are beginning to look for “thick ” history and field work to support their empirical argument. (EL2) Secondly, the focus of economic science has moved from a preoccupation with abstract, equilibrium theorizing to an extensively empirical discipline. (IL) Indeed, empiricism in the form of econometric analysis can also suffer from problems of abstraction and a loss of reality, but economists have greater relevance and a closer attachment to the “real” when engaging in empirical analysis relative to formal theory.

No one knows for certain the origin of the custom that allows women to propose marriage on Leap Day. Leap Day is February 29th, the extra day added every fourth year to put the calendar year in synch with the solar year. One explanation of the custom comes from Ireland. According to Irish legend, Saint Bridgid, an Irish holy woman who lived in the 5th century, complained to Saint Patrick about women having to wait for men to propose. Saint Patrick agreed that this practice was unfair, so he decided that eager females could propose on this one day. A different explanation of the custom comes from medieval England. According to this explanation, people there thought that because Leap Day existed to fix a problem in the calendar, it could also be used to fix an old and unjust practice. In 1288, the custom became an actual law in Scotland. Not only did the Scottish law allow women to propose on any day during Leap year, but it also said that any man who declined a woman proposal had to pay a fine. Whatever its origins, the tradition of women taking the initiative one day a year lives on in Sadie Hawkins day celebrations held in many communities in the United States even today.
