Publisher limits for downloading part of an eBook

Chapter download, print, email & save
100 pages allowed.

❗ Publisher page limits reached
You have reached the number of pages available to download determined by the publisher. [What are page limits?](#)

- **The limit ranges from 15 to 100 pages, and once used up, it is reset:**
 - After successful manual logout from the platform
 - After 24 hours of inactivity (standard timeout)
- **In case of institutional federated authentication for remote access, automatic logout may occur after a shorter period of inactivity (this depends on your institution's specifications)**
- **The limit is applied at the user level**

If the limit does not reset after logging out, we recommend clearing the browser's cache and cookies.

How to search for eBooks by format?

- For EPUB, add **AND FM EK** after your search terms
- For PDF, add **AND FM EB** after your search terms
- We recommend placing a phrase or multiple keywords connected by the operators **AND/OR/NOT** in parentheses:

(artificial intelligence or ai or a.i.) AND FM EK

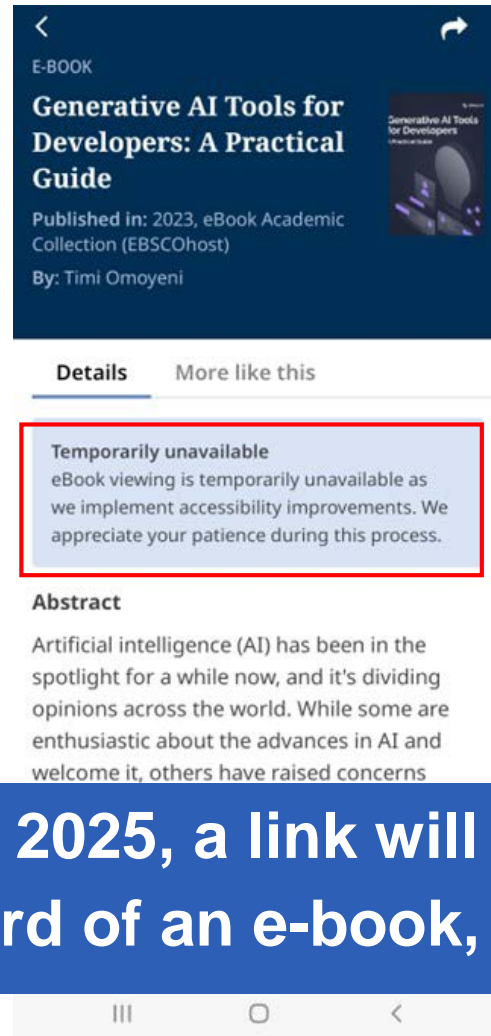

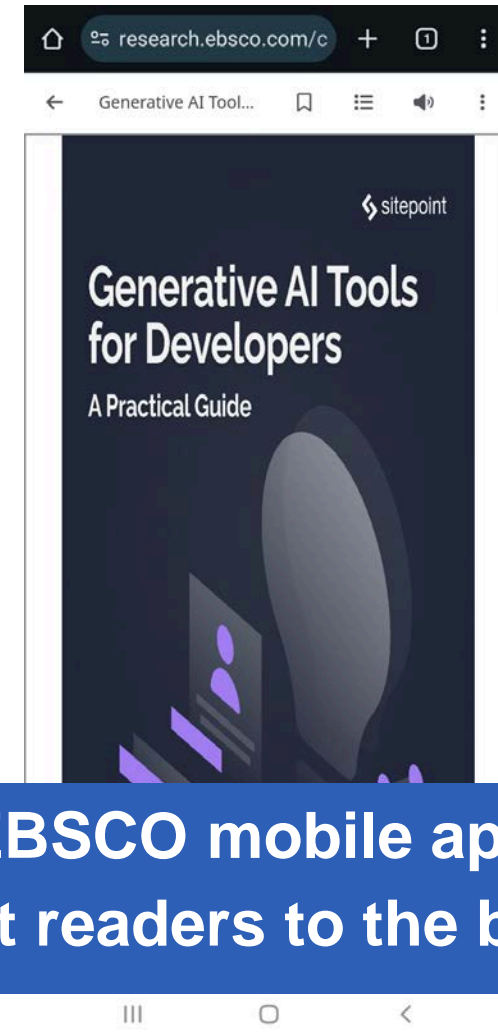
