Autorska prava, otvoreni pristup informacijama i lična elektronska biblioteka

Intelektualna svojina

Obuhvata autorsko pravo i pravo industrijske svojine. Zakoni su nacionalni, ali postoji jaka međunarodna regulativa.

Zakoni kojima se štiti intelektualna svojina mogu da predstavljaju ozbiljnu prepreku za ostvarivanje prava na slobodu informisanja, predviđena Univerzalnom deklaracijom o ljudskim pravima.

Istim zakonima regliše se intelektualna svojina u sferi nauke i obrazovanja, industrije i zabave.



Autorsko pravo

Nacionalni zakon o autorskom pravu štiti od bespravnog korišćenja pisana dela, baze podataka, softver, muzička dela, tonske zapise, koreografiju, likovna i arhitektonska dela.

Zakon štiti i ekspresiju ideja, procedure, metode, koncepte, otkrića, izbor, uređivanje činjenica u bazama podataka, ali ne i same činjenice.

Ideje nisu zaštićene, ali izražavanje ideja i umnožavanje autorskih dela jeste.



Autorsko pravo

Zaštita autorskog dela počinje momentom njegovog fiksiranja u bilo kom mediju – papirnom, elektronskom, magnetnom itd.

Autor ima pravo na to da se delo uvek pripisuje njemu i da se čuva integritet dela. Da bi delo bilo publikovano (umnoženo i distribuirano), autori prenose ugovorom svoja prava na izdavača.

To ih može dovesti u nepovoljnu poziciju, da ne mogu da koriste sopstvene rezultate u nastavi, kasnijim radovima, na vebajtu i sl.

Treba veoma pažljivo čitati ugovore sa izdavačima!

Autorska prava za pisana dela

- Nosioci su ili izdavači (oko 80%) ili autori
- Nasledna su i važe do 70 godina od smrti autora ili koautora
- Za mnoga dela iz 20. veka ne zna se ko je nosilac autorskog prava (izdavači više ne postoje, autorovi naslednici nisu poznati ...)
- Google je započeo sa skeniranjem svih knjiga iz fondova velikih biblioteka, ali su ga udruženi izdavači SAD tužili sudu, sporazum koji su postigli sud je poništio ...

Autorska prava i plagijarizam

- Plagijarizam je korišćenje tuđih reči i rezultata bez navođenja originalnog izvora.
- Danas se to lako otkriva uz pomoć široko dostupnih softvera, kao i Google i Yahoo pretraživača.
- Za razliku od bespravnog umnožavanja nije krivično delo, ali podleže disciplinskoj i moralnoj odgovornosti, posebno u nauci.

Autorska prava i biblioteke

Dok je većina informacija bila u štampanom obliku, biblioteke su bile ustanove koje su omogućavale svim građanima sveta da dođu do potrebnih informacija pozajmljujući knjige, časopise i drugu građu koju su imale u vlasništvu.

Danas one nisu vlasnici elektronskih izvora, nego samo korisnici koji su platili kolektivnu licencu za pristup.

Elektronske publikacije

O odredbama velikog broja licenci ne može se pregovarati – one su unapred zadate i korisnik, bio to pojedinac ili biblioteka, ih prihvata klikom na polje “**I agree**” prilikom pristupa elektronskom dokumentu – filmu, muzici, softveru itd.

Licencnim ugovorima koje potpisuju sa onima na čijem se serveru nalazi materijal koji im je potreban, biblioteke mogu da obezbede i prava koja prevazilaze okvira prava korišćenja prema zakonima o autorskim pravima.

Elektronske publikacije

Tako na primer preko KoBSON-a ne postoji ograničenje koliko puta će neki članak biti skinut sa sajta izdavača, već samo ograničenje da se ne može preuzeti ceo broj od korica do korica odjednom.

Kada ne bi bilo licencnog ugovora kojim je to regulisano, to bi po zakonu o autorskim pravima bila povreda prava na umnožavanje dela, jer to pravo pripada isključivo nosiocu autorskih prava.

Nekomercijalne licence

Za korisnike je posebno značajan materijal koji je preko interneta dostupan u režimu otvorenog pristupa, ali za koji se zna ko je autor, odnosno ko preuzima odgovornost za sadržaj.


Ovakav materijal je često zaštićen nekomercijalnim licencama, kao što su na primer **GNU** ili **Creative Commons** licence.

Postoji i mnogo materijala na svetskoj mreži koji nije zaštićen nikakvim licencama.

Ugovori autora i časopisa

Većina časopisa, posebno komercijalnih, traži da autor prenese isključivo pravo na svoj rad na izdavača časopisa.

Ukoliko ugovor ne predviđa neke izuzetke, to znači da autor ako želi da pošalje kolegama ili studentima tekst, mora da traži odobrenje od izdavača, i da plati naknadu nosiocu autorskih prava – izdavaču!



Komercijalni časopisi

Većinu najuticajnijih časopisa objavljuje nekoliko komercijalnih izdavača (Elsevier, Springer, Wiley-Blackwell, Taylor and Francis ...), i na njima enormno zarađuju, dižući cene svake godine za nekoliko %.

Pošto praktično drže monopol na “kvalitetnu” nauku, umesto servisa za širenje rezultata istraživanja, postali su kočnica jer su zbog cene nedostupni mnogima.

Otvoreni pristup

Apsurdna situacija, u kojoj na rezultatima rada naučnika koji su istraživanja vršili koristeći društvene fondove zarađuju komercijalni izdavači, dovela je do stvaranja Pokreta za otvoreni pristup **Open access (OA)**.

Otvoreni pristup podrazumeva da svaki korisnik koji ima pristup internetu bilo gde u svetu ima pravo da čita, preuzima, čuva, štampa i koristi digitalni sadržaj radova objavljenih u otvorenom pristupu, sa jedinom obavezom da ih korektno citira.



Otvoreni pristup

Otvoreni pristup naučnoj literaturi ostvaruje se u dva glavna, međusobno komplementarna oblika:

- **samoarhiviranjem i izgradnjom mreže institucionalnih ili disciplinarnih repozitorija,** kojima se povećava dostupnost i vidljivost naučne produkcije određene institucije, ili određene naučne discipline, pri čemu je rad moguće uneti pre recenziranja (preprint), ili već recenziran i negde objavljen (postprint); (**GREEN**)
- **objavljivanjem radova u časopisima koji su u otvorenom pristupu, u potpunosti ili delimično - tzv. hibridni časopisi (**GOLD**).**

Otvoreni pristup

U svakom slučaju pravo pristupa ne zadire u zakon o autorskom pravu, jer **vlasnik autorskog prava kratkom izjavom - licencem (npr. CC licencem)** koja prati delo - daje pristanak na **otvoreni pristup svom radu, s tim da zadržava pravo na nadzor nad celovitošću rada i pravo na ispravno navođenje autorstva.**

Svakom je autoru u interesu da njegov rad bude dostupan što većem broju čitalaca, kako bi rezultati njegovih istraživanja imali što veći odjek, što može uticati i na napredovanje njegove karijere.

Otvoreni pristup člancima

Danas je već 10-15% naučnih časopisa u režimu otvorenog pristupa i njihov broj stalno raste, a 90% izdavača dozvoljava da autori preprinte prihvaćene za objavlјivanje u njihovim časopisima postave u digitalne repozitorijume svojih institucija (CERN, Harward University, MiT, Berkeley, Max Planck Institute...) ili međunarodne tematske repozitorijume kao **ArXiv** (matematika, fizika, kvantitativna biologija), **PubMed Central** (biomedicina), **RePEc** (ekonomija), itd.





Radicchi, Fortunato, and Castellano [Radicchi, F., Fortunato, S., & Castellano, C. (2008). Universality of citation distributions: Toward an objective measure of scientific impact. *Proceedings of the National Academy of Sciences*, 105(45), 17268–17272] claim that, apart from a scaling factor, all fields of science are characterized by the same citation distribution. We present a large-scale validation study of this universality-of-citation-distributions claim. Our analysis shows that claiming citation distributions to be universal for all fields of science is not warranted. Although many fields indeed seem to have fairly similar citation distributions, there are quite some exceptions as well. We also briefly discuss the consequences of our findings for the measurement of scientific impact using citation-based bibliometric
